



**Central Asian Regional HIV/AIDS Programme announces call for application for small grants aimed to expansion of harm reduction service provision in Kyrgyz Republic.**

Central Asian Regional HIV/AIDS Programme is funded by Department for International Development (DFID) and implemented by GRM International in partnership with Soros Foundation Kyrgyzstan.

CARHAP Programme has established a grant fund to provide small grants for harm reduction service providers. Small grants are called to be additional funding to existing harm reduction activities.

**Types of assistance within small grants:**

1. *Service funding* in the form of support of staff, IEC materials, conducting of BCC activities.
2. *Technical Assistance Grants* in the form of consultant support, capacity building and training or seminars providing.

**Application procedure:**

CARHAP is using one-step application procedure: organizations are invited to submit filled application forms, which then will be assessed by Programme Board.

**Submission of applications:**

The Programme will run until August 2009. Organizations who intend to apply for a small grant must submit an application form by the end of CARHAP Programme. The Programme Board will select successful applicants each quarter. Application forms received by 1st June 2007 are expected to be reviewed by 15th June 2007. All other applications will be reviewed by the Programme Board at subsequent quarterly meetings.
